The financial results of the company for the quarter ended March 31, 2022, which have been extracted from the financial statements audited by the statutory auditors, have been reviewed by the audit committee and approved by the board of directors at their respective meetings held on 30th May-2022. The statutory auditors have expressed unmodified audit opinion.
3. These results have been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act 2013 and other recognized accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
4. As the company's business activity falls within a single primary business segment viz. Manufacturing of ERW pipes, the disclosure requirement of Accounting Standard (Ind AS 108) on "Operating Segment" is not applicable.
5. Due to outbreak of COVID-19 which has been declared as a Pandemic by World Health Organization and subsequent lock down ordered by the Central and State Governments in India, the manufacturing facilities of the Company got affected. The Company in compliance with the necessary instructions/guidelines, resumed its operations in a phased manner, while ensuring health and safety of all the stakeholders. The Company is gradually ramping up its operations depending upon the market conditions. This situation has disturbed the economic activity through interruption in manufacturing process, disruption in supply chain, etc. The management has exercised due care in concluding significant accounting judgements and estimates after taking into account possible impact of internal and external factors known to the management upto the date of these financial statements, to assess and finalise their carrying amount of assets and liabilities. Accordingly, as on date no material impact is anticipated in these financial statements. Further, the Company believes that this Pandemic may not have significant adverse impact on the long term operations and performance of the Company.

S Rlys eliminates unmanned level crossings

Chennai, June 1: The Southern Railway on Tuesday announced that it has completely eliminated unmanned level crossings in Tamil Nadu giving more thrust on safety.



Southern Railway sources said Railways accord paramount importance to the safety of train operations as it is crucial for the safety of rail passengers as well as road users who come in contact with railway lines.

In order to facilitate uninterrupted and safe movement of both rail and road traffic in the areas of rail-road interface, Railways, in coordination with civic authorities construct Road Over Bridges(ROB), Road Under Bridges (RUB) and Limited Use Subways (LUS). ROB, RUBs and LUS enhance the safety of train operations, besides improving the speed of trains. During the eight year period from 2014 to 2022, 92 ROB & RUBs have been commissioned in the state of Tamil Nadu. Focusing on curbing trespassing accidents involving road/rail commuters and road vehicles at level crossings and enable smooth flow of road/rail traffic, Railways are eliminating Level Crossings on

mission mode. In lieu of Level Crossings, ROB, RUBs and subways are constructed. In Tamil Nadu, a total of 639 unmanned level crossings and 262 manned level crossings have been eliminated during the 8-year period from 2014 to 2022. Enhancing safety, 100% elimination of unmanned level crossing gates was achieved in September 2018 in the rail network spanning over Tamil Nadu state. The manned level crossing gates are being eliminated in phased manner by Railways, the sources said

US to start in-person tourist visa

US, June 1: The United States will soon be resuming regular in-person tourist appointments from September.
