Silver notice

The Interpol has issued the first Silver notice on India's request to track the global assets of former French Embassy officer Shubham Shokeen, who is wanted in connection with a visa fraud, officials said.

The Silver notice is a colour-coded notice introduced by the Interpol in January this year to track the movement of illicit assets across the globe. The pilot project, of which India is also a part, started with the issuance of the first Silver notice on the request of Italy.

The Interpol issues nine types of colour-coded notices, each meant for seeking specific information from member countries worldwide. For instance, Red is for detaining a fugitive, Blue for seeking additional information, Black for unidentified bodies and Yellow for missing persons.

India is among the 51 member countries taking part in the first phase of Silver notice issuance. The pilot project will continue till November.

As part of the pilot phase, each country can get nine Silver notices published.

According to the statement, the Interpol has issued two Silver notices in quick succession on the CBI's request. The first request was made on May 23 against Shokeen, Personnel Visas and Local Law Officer in the French Embassy in Delhi, and the second on May 26 against Amit Madanlal Lakhanpal wanted by the Enforcement Directorate.

"During the period

"Through Silver notices and Diffusions, member countries can request information on assets linked to a person's criminal activities such as fraud, corruption, drug trafficking, environmental crime and other serious offences," the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) said in a statement on Tuesday.

It said the notice will facilitate locating, identifying and obtaining information about laundered assets including properties, vehicles, financial accounts and businesses.

Countries may subsequently use such information as a basis for bilateral engagement, including bilateral requests for seizure, confiscation or recovery of assets, subject to national laws, the agency said.

from September 2019 to May 2022, Shokeen conspired with other accused persons and facilitated issuance of Schengen visa to applicants by collecting illegal gratification ranging from Rs 15,00,000 to Rs 45,00,000 from each," the CBI spokesperson said in the statement.

He said the accused used the proceeds of crime to acquire six immovable properties worth 7,760,500 dirhams (Rs 15,73,51,250) in Dubai.

Earlier, the CBI had got a Blue notice published against Shokeen to trace his whereabouts.

The CBI is the nodal body in India for everything related to the Interpol. All the law enforcement agencies in the country route their requests seeking assistance from the Interpol through the CBI.

L a k h a n p a l, who is wanted by the Enforcement Directorate, allegedly created a cryptocurrency

named MTC, which is not recognised in India, for his own financial gains, the statement said.

"He lured investors to invest in MTC and collected funds of about Rs 113.10 crore from them. He did so without requisite permission and license from the government or the Reserve Bank of India," it said.

The CBI said Lakhanpal did not return the invested amount to depositors as promised by him while collecting the funds. "He embezzled the collected funds and cheated the investors. To lure people, he posed as the authorised representative of the Ministry of Finance," the agency said.

The statement said India has already submitted requests for publication of silver notices in cases being investigated by the CBI, the Enforcement Directorate, and the Narcotics Control Bureau.

SpaceX Starship tumbles out of control, breaks apart

Texas, May 28: After back-to-back explosions, SpaceX launched its mega rocket Starship again on Tuesday evening, but fell short of the main objectives when the spacecraft tumbled out of control and broke apart.

The 123-metre rocket blasted off on its ninth demo from Star-base, SpaceX's launch site at the southern tip of Texas. Residents voted this month to organise as an official city.

CEO Elon Musk's SpaceX hoped to release a series of mock satellites following liftoff, but that got nixed because the door failed to open all the way. Then the spacecraft began spinning as it skimmed space toward an uncontrolled landing in the Indian Ocean.

SpaceX later confirmed that the spacecraft experienced "a rapid unscheduled disassembly", or burst apart.

"Teams will continue to review data and work toward our next flight test," the company said in an online statement.

Musk noted in a post on X it was a "big improvement" from the two previous demos, which ended in flaming debris over the Atlantic.

Despite the latest

setback, he promised a faster launch pace moving forward, with a Starship soaring every three to four weeks for the next three flights.

It was the first time one of Musk's Starships -- intended for moon and Mars travel -- flew with a recycled booster. There were no plans to catch the booster with giant chopsticks back at the launch pad, with the company instead pushing it to its limits.

Contact with the booster was lost at one point, and it slammed into the Gulf of Mexico in pieces as the spacecraft continued toward the Indian Ocean.

Then the spacecraft went out of control, apparently due to fuel leaks.

"Not looking great with a lot of our on-orbit objectives for today," SpaceX flight commentator Dan Huot said.

The company had been looking to test the spacecraft's heat shield during a controlled re-entry.

Communication ceased before the spacecraft came down, and SpaceX ended its webcast soon afterward.

The previous two Starships never made it past the Caribbean. The

demos earlier this year ended just minutes after liftoff, raining wreckage into the ocean. No injuries or serious damage were reported, although airline travel was disrupted.

The Federal Aviation Administration last week cleared Starship for another flight, expanding the hazard area and pushing the liftoff outside peak air travel times.

Besides taking corrective action and making upgrades, SpaceX modified the latest spacecraft's thermal tiles and installed special catch fittings.

This one was meant to sink in the Indian Ocean, but the company wanted to test the add-ons for capturing future versions back at the pad, just like the boosters.

NASA needs SpaceX to make major strides over the next year with Starship - the biggest and most powerful rocket ever built - in order to land astronauts back on the moon.

Next year's moonshot with four astronauts will fly around the moon, but will not land. That will happen in 2027 at the earliest and require a Starship to get two astronauts from lunar orbit to the surface and back off again.

The US State Department has halted the scheduling of new visa interviews for foreign students hoping to study in the US while it prepares to expand the screening of their activity on social media, officials said.

A US official said Tuesday the suspension is intended to be temporary and does not apply to applicants who already had scheduled their visa interviews.

The official spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss an internal administration document.

A cable signed by Secretary of State Marco Rubio and obtained by a news agency says the State Department plans to issue guidance on expanded social media vetting.

"Effective immediately, in preparation for an expansion of required social media screening and vetting, consulate sections should not add any additional student or exchange visitor visa appointment capacity" until the guidance is issued, the cable says.

Asked about the suspension at a briefing Tuesday, State Department spokesperson Tammy Bruce said the US uses every available resource to vet people applying for visas.

State Department Spokesperson Tammy Bruce, in her briefing on Tuesday, was asked about a possible decision by the Trump administration that will require all foreign students to undergo social media vetting.

"Well, if you're discussing that, that's

something that has not been discussed publicly. It would have to be leaked material if it exists. What I can remind everyone of, which we've discussed for months here, is that we use every tool in our tool chest to vet anyone coming in who wants to come into this country, and in order to do so has to apply for a visa to gain access to our nation," Bruce said.

"Every nation should take seriously -- and does -- who's coming in. So if you're going to be applying for a visa, follow the normal process, the normal steps. Expect to be looked at, and we go on from there," Bruce said.

The move, first reported by *Politico*, is the latest in the Donald Trump administration's crackdown on international

students.

Last week, the Trump administration revoked Harvard University's ability to enrol international students, removing the college from the programme that allows schools to sponsor foreign students for visas.

That effort was quickly challenged in court and for now is blocked by a federal judge.

This spring, the administration also revoked the legal status of thousands of international students already in the country, leading some to leave the US out of fear of deportation.

After many students filed successful legal challenges, the administration said it was restoring the students' legal status. But the government also expanded the grounds for

terminating international students' legal status going forward.

Trump's previous administration stepped up scrutiny of all visa applicants, introducing reviews of their social media accounts. The policy remained during former president Joe Biden's administration.

An extended pause in scheduling student visas could lead to delays that may disrupt college, boarding-school or exchange students' plans to enrol in summer and fall terms.

A downturn in enrolment of international students could hurt university budgets. To make up for cuts in federal research funding, some colleges shifted to enrolling more international students, who often pay full tuition.

UN posthumous honour for 2 Indian peacekeepers

United Nations, May 28:

Two Indian peacekeepers who lost their lives while serving under the UN flag last year will be honoured posthumously by the United Nations as it commemorates International Day of UN Peacekeepers this week.

Brigadier General Amitabh Jha, who served with the UN Disengagement Observer Force (UNDOF), and Havildar Sanjay Singh, who was deployed with the UN Stabilisation Mission in the Democratic Republic of Congo (MONUSCO), will be honoured posthumously with the Dag Hammarskjold medal at a solemn ceremony here on May 29 on the occasion of International Day of United Nations Peacekeepers, a statement said.

India is the 4th largest contributor of uniformed personnel to UN Peacekeeping. It currently deploys more than 5,300 military and police personnel to the UN peace operations in Abyei, the Central African Republic, the Democratic Republic of the Congo, Lebanon, Somalia, South Sudan, and Western Sahara.

During ceremonies at the world body's headquarters to mark Peacekeepers Day, UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres will lay a wreath to honour the more than 4,400 UN peacekeepers who have lost their lives since 1948.

Guterres will also preside over a ceremony at which the Dag Hammarskjold Medals will be awarded posthumously to 57 military, police, and civil-

ian peacekeepers who lost their lives serving under the UN flag last year.

The Secretary-General will also present awards to the 2024 Military Gender Advocate of the Year, Squadron Leader Sharon Mwinote Syme from Ghana, and the UN Woman Police Officer of the Year award to Superintendent Zainab Gbla of Sierra Leone. Both of them serve with the United Nations Interim Security Force in Abyei (UNISFA).

Last year, Major Radhika Sen, who served with the United Nations Organisation Stabilisation Mission in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (MONUSCO), received the prestigious '2023 United Nations Military Gender Advocate of the Year

Award' from Guterres.

The theme for this year's International Day of UN Peacekeepers is the 'Future of Peacekeeping', which emphasises that the 'Pact for the Future' -- adopted by world leaders in September last year -- includes a commitment to adapt peacekeeping to the changing world, the statement said.

In his message for the Day, Guterres said that "today, peacekeepers face increasingly complex situations in an increasingly complex world... Now more than ever, the world needs the United Nations - and the United Nations needs peacekeeping that is fully equipped for today's realities and tomorrow's challenges."

Liverpool varsity to open campus in Bengaluru

Bengaluru, May 28:

In a milestone moment for UK-India education ties, the University of Liverpool, a member of the prestigious Russell Group, on Tuesday announced plans to open Bengaluru's first foreign university campus by 2026, a move that is set to redefine the higher education landscape in Karnataka and beyond.

"This landmark development reinforces Karnataka's position as a global knowledge destination," said Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah.

"We welcome the University of Liverpool wholeheartedly and will extend full support to ensure this venture becomes a grand success." The upcoming campus will be rooted in the University's internationally acclaimed academic standards and research-intensive ethos. It will offer degrees in Business Management, Accounting and Finance, Computer Science, Biomedical Sciences and Game Design, the first time these programmes will be delivered by a UK university on Indian soil. A broader portfolio is expected in the subsequent phases.

Highlighting the significance of the move, Professor Tim Jones, Vice-Chancellor of the University of Liverpool, said, "We are proud to deepen our long-standing relationship with India by opening a world-class campus in Bengaluru. Karnataka's status as a knowledge and technology powerhouse makes it the ideal choice for our first international campus." To further embed the campus within India's dynamic industry ecosystem, the University of Liverpool also inked MoUs (memoranda of

understanding) with leading entities, Wipro Limited, Axis Bank and TiE Bangalore, to build meaningful industry-academic collaborations. These partnerships aim to enable joint research, internships, curriculum design and innovation platforms that will benefit startups, MSMEs, and students alike.

Professor Tariq Ali, pro vice chancellor for Global Engagements and Partnerships, emphasised the strategic importance of such partnerships: "These collaborations will help connect research and education directly with industry needs-creating a rich, application-oriented learning environment for students." The event also featured strong endorsements from other senior ministers. M.C. Sudhakar, Minister for Higher Education, and Dinesh Gundu Rao, Minister for Health & Family Welfare, attended alongside M.B. Patil, Minister for Large & Medium Industries and Infrastructure Development, who stated, "This collaboration will deepen our ties with global academia and catalyse growth across critical sectors like aerospace, biotechnology and electronics."
